

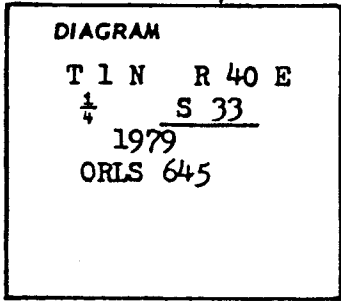
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Z-11

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established in 1863 by Timothy W. Davenport, Deputy Surveyor under Contract No. 102.

Surveyor General's records states:  
Set  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. post. Made mound of rock.



Description of corner evidence found:

At assumed corner location I found mound of stone but no evidence of wood post. Corner location has been confirmed from east & west.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

I set a 2" galv. iron pipe with brass cap approx. 12" above surface of very rocky ground in a mound of stone 3 ft. dia. and 1 ft. high. Cap stamped as shown above.

No bearing trees are available.
