
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

### HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

Corner originally established by Henry Meldrum under GLO contract no. 450, dated June 11, 1882. Surveyor General record states:

At 1/4 corner position, set 14x8x7 basalt stone in mound of stone.



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

#### DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found mound of stone. There are 2 stones of approximate call size, I was unable to find any marks. The stones in this area are quite fractured.

# DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:


In place of stone mound, I set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown below, 15" in the ground, with mound of stone 3 feet wide at the base, from which;

A 5/8"x30" iron pin (rebar) bears N56°E, 25.10 feet, with 2" aluminum cap marked "NE RP".

A 5/8"x30" iron pin (rebar) bears S29°E, 25.48 feet, with 2" aluminum cap marked "SE RP".

A 5/8"x30" iron pin (rebar) bears S75°W, 30.84 feet.

A 5/8"x30" iron pin (rebar) bears N14°W, 11.55 feet, with 2" aluminum cap marked "NW RP".


## HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Corner originally established by Henry Meldrum under  ${\tt GLO}$  contract no. 450, dated June 11, 1882. Surveyor General record staes:

Set basalt stone  $14 \times 9 \times 7$  ins, 10 inches in ground for 1/4 sec. corner marked 1/4 on N face and raised mound of stone along side, pits impracticable.

In 1994 Duane Griffith found a mound of stone. Union County Monumentation Record 004-1994R states: "There are 2 stones of approximate call size, I was unable to find any mark. The stones in this area are quite fractured." In place of stone mound he set a 2 1/2"x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown below, 15" in the ground, with mound of stone 3' wide at the base, from which;





A 5/8"x30" iron pin(rebar) bears N56°E, 25.10', with 2" aluminum cap marked "NE RP".

A 5/8"x30" iron pin(rebar) bears S29°E, 25.48', with 2" aluminum cap marked "SE RP".

A 5/8"x30" iron pin(rebar) bears S75°W, 30.84'.

A 5/8"x30" iron pin(rebar) bears N14°W, 11.55', with 2" aluminum cap marked "NW RP".

### DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found a 2 1/2" aluminum pipe, 15" above ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below and in a 3 ft diam. mound of stone, from which:

A 5/8" iron pin bears North 56° East, a dist. of 25.10 ft with 1 1/2" alum. cap marked "NE RP", 6" above ground.

A 5/8" iron pin bears South 32° East, a dist. of 25.45 ft with 1 1/2" alum. cap marked "SE 3" above ground.

A 5/8" iron pin bears North 14° West, a dist. of 11.65 ft with 1 1/2" alum. cap marked "NW RP" 10" above ground.

## DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

From the aluminum pipe monument

#### NEW BEARING OBJECT:

A 5/8" iron pin bears South 57° West, a dist. of 22.0 ft with 1 1/2" alum. cap marked UNION COUNTY SURVEYOR.

Set steel fencepost approx. 2.0 ft. Northerly of aluminum pipe mon.
