

At computed position, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown below, 30" in the ground, from which;


A 12" Douglas Fir bears S89°E, 11.35 feet, marked "N 1/16 S7 BT".

A 10" Douglas Fir bears N53°W, 14.15 feet marked "N 1/16 S12 BT".

Drove steel fence post 5' north.
