

At computed position, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown below, 28" in the ground, from which;


A 18" Douglas Fir bears N18°E, 41.40 feet, marked "C 1/4 S7 BT".

A 23" Douglas Fir bears S79°E, 29.80 feet, marked "X BT".

A 17" Tamarack bears S44°W, 50.55 feet, marked "C 1/4 S7 BT".

A 18" Tamarack bears N56°W, 62.49 feet, marked "X BT".

Drove steel fence post 5' north.
