

At computed position, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown below, 12" in the ground, with a mound of stone 3 feet wide at the base, from which;

A 16" Ponderosa Pine bears S29°E, 119.1 feet, marked "E 1/16 S18 BT".

A 17" Douglas Fir bears N78°W, 28.38 feet marked "E 1/16 S7 BT".

Drove steel fence post 5' north.
