

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by William H. Odell and Joseph G. Gray under glo joint contract number 120, dated May 27, 1867 Surveyor General record states:

A pine 42 in dia bears N80°E 65 1ks A pine 30 in dia bears S15°W 64 1ks



### Description of corner evidence found:

Found 40 inch diameter pine stump  $N80^{\circ}E$  42.9 feet, scribes visible Found 30 inch diameter pine stump  $S15^{\circ}V$  42.2 feet, no scribes visible

original location of this corner: At record bearing and distance from BT stumps, I set a  $2^{\frac{1}{2}}$  inch x 30 inch aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 30 inches in the ground from which:


