

A 28" Ponderosa Pine bears S. 15° E., a distance of 6.40 feet, marked X BT.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on February 29, 2008.



I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new bearing trees. The magnetic declination used was 18° East. The distance to the bearing tree is to a 50d spike driven on the right side of the tree at the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 991 to the BT blaze.
