At the position determined by Survey: I set a 5/8"x 30" rebar with 2 1/2" Aluminum cap marked as shown below, 30" in the ground, from which;

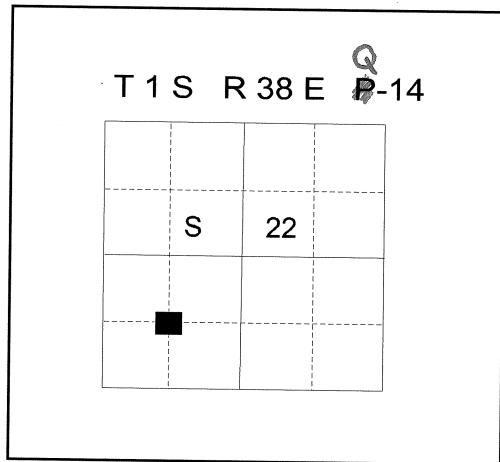
**NEW BEARING TREES:**

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on July 24, 2011.

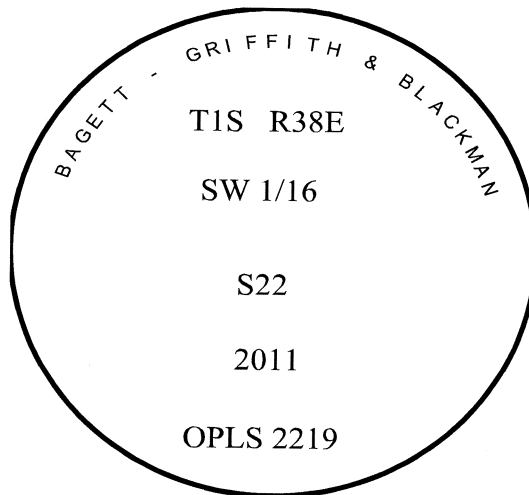
