

NEW BEARING TREES:

An 8" Ponderosa Pine bears North 4° East, a distance of 25.38 feet, marked E1/16 S21 BT.

A 9" Ponderosa Pine bears South 12° West, a distance of 21.23 feet, marked E1/16 S28 BT.

Set steel fence post 0.5 ft. Northwesterly of corner monument.



I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. The magnetic declination used was 16 East. The distance to the bearing trees are to a 50d spike driven on the right side of the tree at the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 2219 to the BT blaze.
