

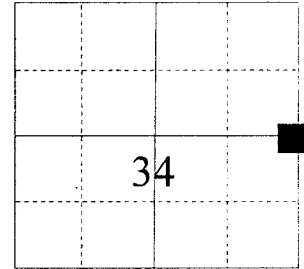

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

Corner originally established by David P. Thompson under GLO contract Number 103, dated September 3, 1863. Surveyor General record states:
Set post for 1/4 sec cor in mound of earth with charred stake, pits, trench as per instructions

T 1 S R 38 E X-17



Survey No. 37-74 states "stone found at E 1/4 corner"

No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found stone 14x12x6 with faint marks visible. Stone loose on west side of irrigation ditch.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

I reestablished the corner position at the record position of survey no. 37-74. As described above, the position falls on the bank of an irrigation ditch. I therefore set a 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown below, 36" in the ground for a reference monument.

- New Bearing Objects: (Bearing and distance are to the TRUE corner position)
- A 5/8 x 30 inch iron rebar with aluminum cap bears N38°E, a distance of 17.65 feet, marked NE RP.
 - A 5/8 x 30 inch iron rebar with aluminum cap bears S41°E, a distance of 18.54 feet, marked SE RP.
 - A 2½ inch aluminum cap bears S76°W, a distance of 12.95 feet, marked as shown below.
 - A 5/8 x 30 inch iron rebar with aluminum cap bears N35°W, a distance of 17.53 feet, marked NW RP.

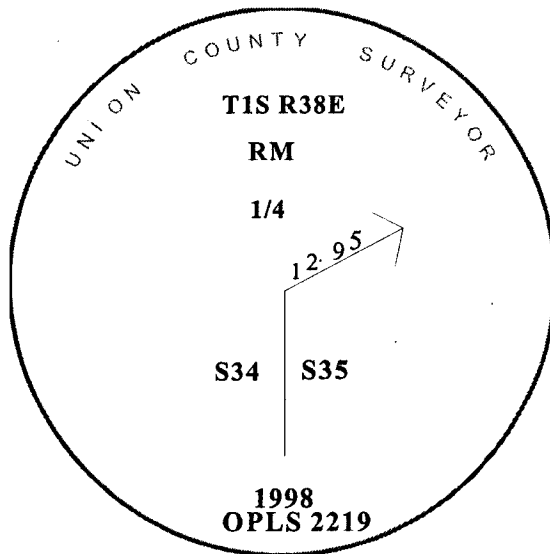
