

A 4' diam. embedded mound of stone with a wood remnant on the East side of the mound. Area is otherwise devoid of wood.

Ancient rock jacks bear North/South with wire remnants

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At mound of stone position, I set a 2 1/2" with 3" aluminum pipe, 15" in the ground, aluminum cap marked as shown and in a 4 ft diameter mound of stone, from which:

A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears North  $56^{\circ}13$ ' East a dist. of 23.28 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked NE RP

A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears South 33°48' East a dist. of 23.35 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked SE RP

A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears South 50°52' West a dist. of 31.28 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap

marked SW RP A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears North  $51^{\circ}02$ ' West a dist. of 25.11 feet, with 1 12" aluminum cap marked NW RP
