

## NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 12" Ponderosa Pine bears North 82° East, a dist. of 100.15 feet, marked W 1/16 S13 BT. A 10" White Fir bears South 26° West, a dist. of 29.80 feet, marked W 1/16 S 24 BT.

Set steel fence post approx. 0.5 feet north of monument.
