
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Corner originally established by David P. Thompson under GLO Contract Number 103, dated July 3rd, 1863. Surveyor General Field Notes state:

Set post for 1/4 sec cor in mound of stone

In Survey Number 10, Voelz found the original 1/4 corner.



DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

None. Position falls on side slope of forest road.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At proportionate position, I set a $5/8" \times 15"$ iron pin with 1 1/2" aluminum cap, 15 inches in the ground marked as shown below, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 10" Ponderosa Pine bears North, a dist. of 23.60 feet, marked 1/4 S26 BT


A 17" Ponderosa Pine bears South 48° East, a dist. of 60.95 feet, marked 1/4 S26 BT

A 6" Ponderosa Pine bears South 56° West, a dist. of 43.55 feet, marked 1/4 S27 BT

A 8" Ponderosa Pine bears North 64° West, a dist. of 27.00 feet, marked 1/4 S27 BT
