

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 29" in the ground, with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below and in a 1 ft diam. mound of stone, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 6" Ponderosa Pine bears North 76° West, a dist. of 42.65 ft, marked W 1/16 S26 BT A 5" Douglas Fir bears North 6° West, a dist. of 37.35 ft, marked W 1/16 S26 BT.
