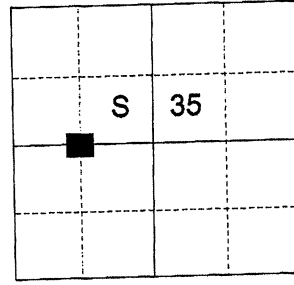

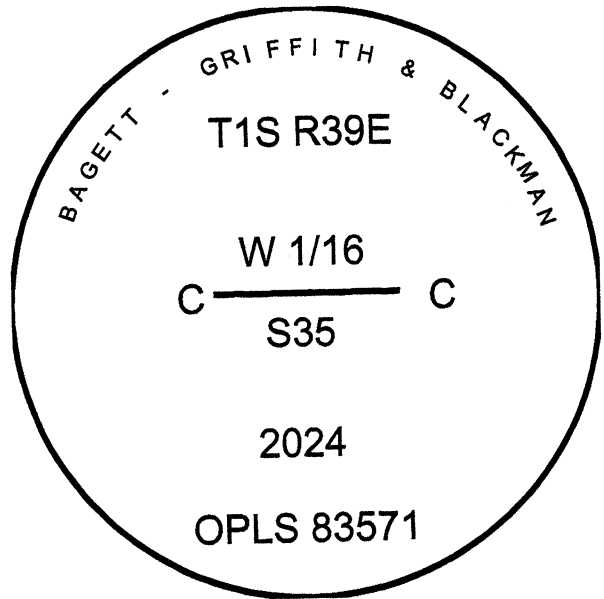
DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 29" in the ground, with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 6" Ponderosa Pine bears South 2° West, a dist. of 33.40 ft, marked CW 1/16 S35 BT
A 9" Ponderosa Pine bears South 84° East, a dist. of 56.25 ft, marked CW 1/16 S35 BT

Falls South of Northeast/Southwest running power line and approx. 30 ft. East of North/South running forest road
