

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 30 inches in the ground, from which:

A 6 inch Lodgepole Pine bears North 57° East, a distance of 21.25 feet, marked C1/4 S36 BT. A 6 inch Western Larch bears South 37° East, a distance of 23.65 feet, marked C1/4 S36 BT. A 15 inch White Fir bears South 10° West, a distance of 26.05 feet, marked C1/4 S36 BT. A 10 inch White Fir bears North, a distance of 55.00 feet, marked C1/4 S36 BT.

I set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot North of the corner monument. I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on October 7, 2013.
