

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 26" in the ground, with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, in 1.5 ft. diam. mound of stone, from which:

A 5" Ponderosa Pine bears North 70° East, a dist. of 15.25 ft, marked SE 1/16 S35 BT A 9" Ponderosa Pine bears North 4° West, a dist. of 39.75 ft, marked SE 1/16 S35 BT

Set steel fencepost 1 ft. East

Approx. corner post with tag bears South 72° West, a distance of 23.00 ft.
