
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Corner originally established by Henry Meldrum under GLO contract number 450 dated June 11th, 1882. Surveyor General field notes state:

Set basalt stone 27x15x12 ins., 21 ins. in ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on N. face and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.



DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found a 21"x15"x10" basalt stone, loosely set, marked 1/4 on top face, from which:
A 5' diam. mound of stone bears approx. 10 ft. West

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position of found stone, I set a 2 1/2" aluminum pipe, 6" in the ground, to bedrock, with 3" aluminum cap marked as shown and in a 4 ft. diam. mound of stone, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8" iron pin bears North $64^{\circ}16$ ' East a dist. of 13.96 ft., with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER NE RP"

A basalt stone, 3'x2'x1' exposed bears South 27°22' East a dist. of 26.74 ft., chiseled "X BO" on North face.

A 5/8" iron pin bears South 64°29' West a dist. of 13.12 ft., with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER SW RP"

A basalt stone, 3'x2'x1' exposed, bears North 19°30' West a dist. of 17.80 ft., chiseled "X BO" on South face.
