Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

I set a 2" galv. iron pipe with brass cap approx. 12" above surface of ground in a mound of stone 3 ft. dia. and  $l^{\frac{1}{2}}$  ft. high. Cap stamped as shown above.
