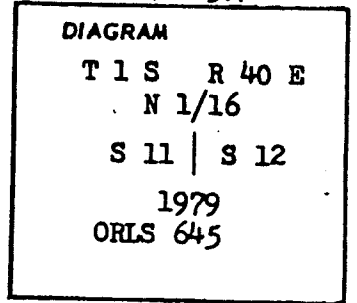


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

I set a 1" galv. iron pipe with brass cap in a mound of stone 3 ft. in dia. and 2 ft. high. Hit rock so could not bury monument. Cap stamped as shown above.

I set two bearing trees:

A 12" P. pine bears N 27 E, 46.75 ft. scribed 1/16 S BT.

A 10" P. pine bears S 84 E, 34.6 ft. scribed 1/16 S BT.

Trees available in section 11 were too large or not suitable to be a good bearing tree.
