

At the position determined by survey I set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap marked as shown below, 26" in the ground, from which:

A 16" Ponderosa Pine bears N75°E, 54.31 feet, marked W 1/16 S7 BT. A 15" Ponderosa Pine bears S15°E, 59.79 feet, marked W 1/16 S18 BT.
