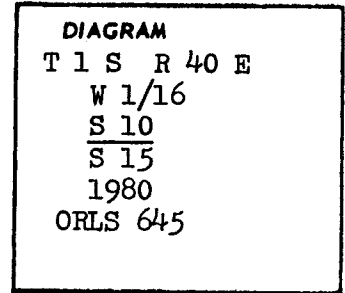

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Corner originally established by James Hambleton in Survey No. 32-80, dated 5-20-80. Union County mounumentation record states:

I set a 1" galv. iron pipe 30" long with a brass cap, 4" above the surface, in a mound of stone, with cap stamped as shown below. I set two new bearing trees:

An 8" fir bears N 53 39 E, 24.75 feet and scribed 1/16 S BT.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found a 2 1/2" iron pipe with 2 1/2" brass cap, marked as shown below, flush with ground and in a mound of stone 2 foot diameter. From which:

A 14" Douglas Fir alive and vigorous with a healed blaze, bears South 21° East, a distance of 40.65 feet.

A 14" Douglas Fir bears North 8° East, a distance of 53.00 feet, marked W 1/16 S10 BT.

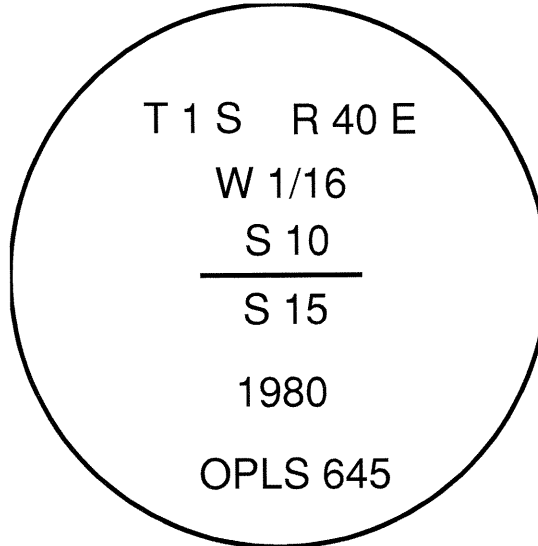
This corner falls on the West side of a North/South running fenceline.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessory. I used 16° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing tree. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing tree.
