A 9" tamarack bears N 58 W, 15 lks. mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.

A 36" pine bears S 24 W, 12 lks. mkd. 1 S BT.

Description of corner evidence found:

At assumed corner location found 18 x 10 x 8" basalt stone 12" above ground in good condition with $\frac{1}{4}$ marked on the N face. Also found 20" larch stump with face grown over and partially cut open bearing N 58 W, 15 1ks.

Also found badly rotted pine remains of a stump fitting the bearing tree calls in Sec. 13

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

I set a 2" galv. iron pipe with brass cap approx. 6" above ground surface in a mound of stone with cap stamped as shown above. Placed original stone upside down on W

Set two new bearing trees:

A 10" larch bears N 26 W, 51.25 ft. and scribed \$\frac{1}{4}\$ S BT.

A 9" larch bears S 69 E, 20.0 ft. and scribed 1 S BT.
