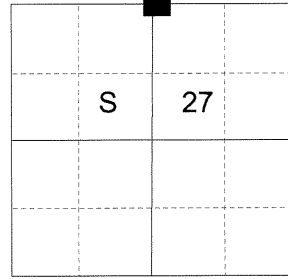


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Corner originally established by Henry Meldrum in GLO Contract Number 450, dated June 11, 1882. Surveyor General Field Notes state:
Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 inches square, 24 in. in ground for 1/4 sec cor. marked 1/4 S. on N. face, from which:
A pine 10 ins. in dia, bears N10°E 6 lks. dist marked 1/4 S BT.
A pine 12 ins. in dia, bears S35°W 5 lks. dist marked 1/4 S BT.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the proportionate position, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe 25" in the ground, with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below. From which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

An 8" Lodgepole Pine bears North 59° East, a distance of 13.85 feet, marked 1/4 S22 BT.
An 8" Lodgepole Pine bears South 49° East, a distance of 3.22 feet, marked 1/4 S27 BT.
An 8" Lodgepole Pine bears South 29° West, a distance of 30.60 feet, marked 1/4 S27 BT.
A 9" Lodgepole Pine bears North 27° West, a distance of 22.35 feet, marked 1/4 S22 BT.

I set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot North of corner monument.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on June 24, 2015.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 16° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
