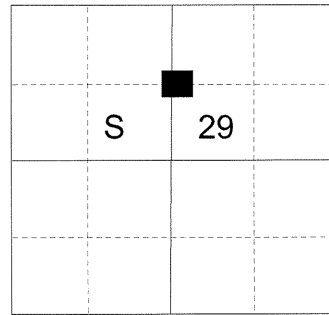

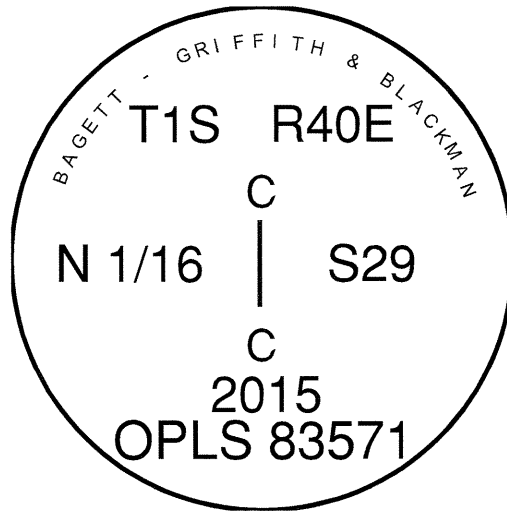
At the position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 30" in the ground. From which:

**NEW BEARING TREES:**

A 6" White Fir bears South 30° West, a distance of 7.20 feet, marked CN 1/16 S29 BT.  
A 12" White Fir bears North 20° West, a distance of 17.85 feet, marked CN 1/16 S29 BT.

I set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot South of the corner monument.

I hereby certify that this corner was monumented on March 2, 2015.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new bearing trees. I used 16° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the new bearing tree. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
