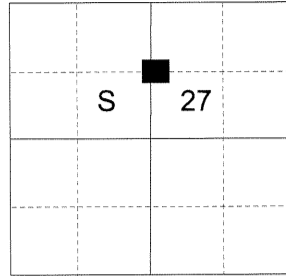

At the position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron rod with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 29" in the ground. From which:

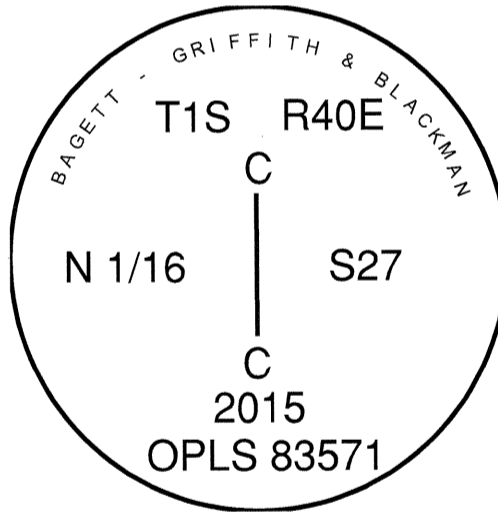
NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 3" Ponderosa Pine bears South 15° West, a distance of 34.30 feet, marked X BT.
A 7" Douglas Fir bears North 21° West, a distance of 69.80 feet, marked CN 1/16 S27 BT.

I set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot North of corner monument.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on June 26, 2015.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 16° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
