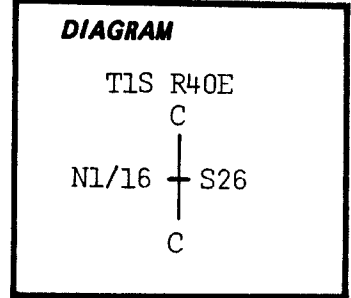

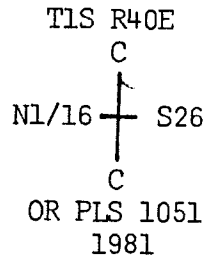


Description of corner evidence found:

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At surveyed point set 1 1/4" x 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 25" in the ground.  
 From which by magnetic declination of N20°E:  
 A 11" Fir bears N61°E., 41.1 ft. scribed CN1/16S26 BT.  
 A 12" Fir bears N52°W., 36.7 ft. scribed CN1/16S26 BT.  
 Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on BTs. Placed 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' south of the corner.
