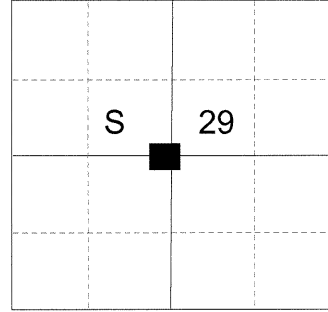

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by survey, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 27" in the ground. From which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

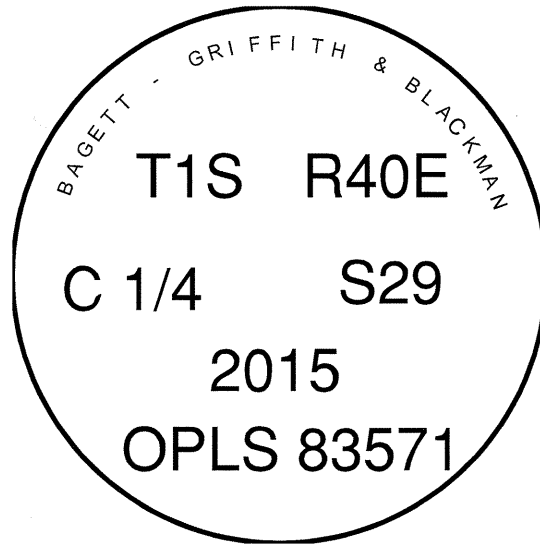
- A 15" White Fir bears North 42° East, a distance of 20.30 feet, marked C1/4 S29 BT.
- A 19" White Fir bears South 60° East, a distance of 45.05 feet, marked C1/4 S29 BT.
- A 17" White Fir bears South 56° West, a distance of 10.65 feet, marked C1/4 S29 BT.
- A 4" White Fir bears North 6° East, a distance of 27.80 feet, marked X BT.

I set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot West of the corner monument.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new bearing trees. I used 16° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the new bearing tree. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
