
# CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally established by Henry Meldrum, Deputy Surveyor, under G.L.O. contract No. 450, during August 1882. Surveyors General's notes state: "Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., mkd. 1/4S on N. face; from which a fir 7 ins. diam. bears S27°E., 20 lks. dist. mkd. 1/4S BT. A fir 10 ins. diam. bears N42°E., 16 lks. dist. mkd. 1/4S BT."



# Description of corner evidence found:

Found no trace of record post or BTs.

# Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At surveyed point set 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 25" in the ground. No rock in the area.

From which by magnetic declination of N20°E:
A 14" fir bears N09°E., 26.7 ft. scribed 1/4S26 BT.
A 9" fir bears N52°W., 24.1 ft. scribed 1/4S27 BT.
Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s; and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on BTs. Placed 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' north of the corner.

### CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

#### HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

Corner originally established by Henry Meldrum in GLO Contract Number 450, dated June 11, 1882. Surveyor General Field Notes state:

Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 inches square, 24 in. in ground for 1/4 Sec. Corner, from which: A spruce 12 ins. in dia. bears S38°E, 9 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S. BT. A Spruce 9 ins. in dia. bears S82°W, 14 lks. dist.,

Corner brought to county standard by Barry Barbour in

Survey Number 57-81 by proportionate measurement. Union County monumentation record 179-84R states:

At surveyed point set 2 ½" x 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 25" in the ground. No rock in the area. From which by magnetic declination of N20°E:

A 14" fir bears N9°E., 26.7 ft. scribed 1/4S26 BT. A 9" fir bears N52°W., 24.1 ft. scribed 1/4S27 BT.

#### DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

marked 1/4 S. BT.

Found a 2 ½" iron pipe with 2 1/2" brass cap marked as shown below, 4 inches above ground, from which:

A 21" White Fir bears North 9° East, a distance of 26.70 feet, alive and vigorous with healed blaze.

A 15 inch White Fir bears North 52° West, a distance of 24.10 feet, alive and vigorous with healed blaze.

#### DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

From the iron pipe monument,

#### NEW BEARING TREES:

A 10 inch Lodgepole Pine bears South  $65^{\circ}$  East, a distance of 25.25 feet, marked 1/4S26 BT.

An 8 inch White Fir bears South 35° West, a distance of 17.35 feet, marked 1/4 S27 BT.
