
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally established by Henry Meldrum, Deputy Surveyor, under G.L.O. contract No. 450, during August 1882. Surveyors General's notes state: "Set post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., mkd. 1/4 on W. face; from which a fir, 12 ins. diam. bears S50°W., 25 lks. dist. mkd., 1/4S BT. An alder, 4 ins. diam. bears N72°E., 35 lks. dist. mkd., 1/4S BT."



Description of corner evidence found:

Found no trace of record post or BTs.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At surveyed point set 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 25" in the ground. From which by magnetic declination of N20°E:
A 14" Fir bears N68°E., 85.9 ft. scribed 1/4S25 BT.
A 11" Fir bears S89°W., 20.9 ft. scribed 1/4S26 BT.
Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on BTs. Placed 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' north of the corner.
