



## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At surveyed point set 1 1/4" x 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 25" in the ground. From which by magnetic declination of N20°E:
A 16" Fir bears S52°E., 37.8 ft. scribed CS1/16S26 BT.
A 16" Fir bears N17°E., 35.9 ft. scribed CS1/16S26 BT.
Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on BTs. Placed 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' north of the corner.
