A 14" Tamarack bears North 12° West a dist. of 11.20 ft., marked W 1/16 S28 BT.

East and South bearing fence corner falls on SE BT.

Monument falls in East/West forest road.

I used 13° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
