
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Original corner established in 1898 by Alonzo Gesner under contract #683. He set a Tamarack Post 4'x4"x4", 24" in ground. From which:

An 18" White Fir bears N0°30'E, 115 lks. A 16" Tamarack bears S74°30'E, 50 lks.



Description of corner evidence found:

No corner monument found.

No bearing trees found.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Cap is stamped:
By single proportioning, I set 2½"x30" aluminum
capped aluminum pipe rising 8" above ground
in a mound of stones.
Set a steel fence post 3 ft. north of corner.

A 16" Doug Fir bears N50½°E, 60.6 ft., blazed&scribed: ½S6BT A 12" Doug Fir bears S55½°E, 56.5 ft., blazed&scribed: ½S7BT

Painted blazes and attached signs as required in <u>Specifications for Cadastral Surveys</u>, USFS Region 6, March,1982. A ½" brass disk stamped "RLS1848" is nailed to lower end of blazes.

To find corner follow Rd. 6200610 Southeasterly % mile from 6200600. Corner is 300 ft. west up the hill on steep easterly slope.
