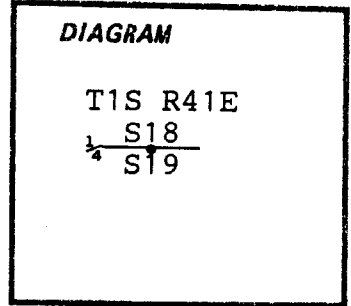


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Index File No. N-03

History of original corner establishment:

Original corner established in 1898 by Alonzo Gesner under contract #683.
He set a White Fir Post 4"x3"x3", 24" in ground.
From which:
A 40" White Fir bears N61°E, 21 lks.
A 14" White Fir bears S3°W, 9 lks.



Description of corner evidence found:

No corner monument found.

A 40" White Fir Stump bears N61°E, 21 lks, no marks.
A 36" White Fir Stump bears East, 39 lks, no marks. (Line tree)
The two fir stumps found fit well for terrain call to the creek 1.7 chains east. They also fit for alignment and distance to the line tree found 13.8 chains East.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

From original evidence, I set 2½"x30" aluminum capped aluminum pipe rising 6" above ground
No stones available.
Set a steel fence post 3 ft. north of corner.

New BT's:

A 12½" Western Larch bears N30°W, 238.2 ft., blazed&scribed: ¼S18BT
A 14" Doug Fir bears S42½°W, 44.4 ft., blazed&scribed: ¼S19BT

Painted blazes and attached signs as required in Specifications for Cadastral Surveys, USFS Region 6, March, 1982. A ¼" brass disk stamped "RLS1848" is nailed to lower end of blazes.

To find corner follow Rd. 6200485
South 600 feet, corner is west across creek 250 feet in opening.
