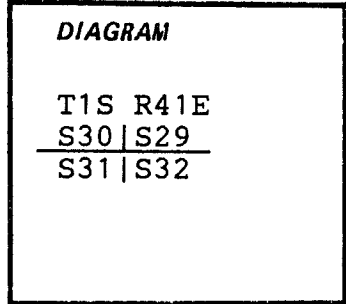
History of original corner establishment:

Original corner established in 1898 by A. Gesner under contract #683.

He set a pine post 4'x4"x4", 24" in ground.

From which:

- A 14" Black Pine bears N68°E, 86 lks.
- An 14" Black Pine bears S74°E, 59 lks.
- An 8" Fir bears S24°W, 120 lks.
- A 9" Spruce bears N87¼°W, 239 lks.



Description of corner evidence found:

No corner monument found.

Bearing trees found:

- A Spruce stump bears N87¼°W, 157.9 ft., no marks visible.
- A dead and down pine, stump in place, bears N68°E, 56.8 ft., scribing visible: T1SR41Es29BT.
- A dead and down tree, badly dacayed, bears S74°E, 38.8 ft.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

From evidence, set 2½"x30" aluminum capped aluminum pipe rising 10" above ground.

No stones available for mound.

Set steel fence post 3 ft. north of corner.

- A 6½" W. Fir bears N55½°W, 18.4 ft., blazed&scribed: T1SR41ES30BT
- A 3" W. Fir bears N69½°E, 32.0 ft., blazed & scribed: "X"BT
- A 7½" Spruce bears S74½°E, 60.8 ft., blazed & scribed: T1SR41ES32BT
- A 7½" Spruce bears S41½°W, 53.2 ft., blazed & scribed T1SR41ES31BT

Painted blazes and attached signs as required in Specifications for Cadastral Surveys, USFS Region 6, March, 1982. A ¾" brass disk stamped "LS1848" nailed to lower end of blazes.

From 6200 follow 6200433 easterly ½ mile to end of road, corner is S70°E, 450' in marshy area.

Compass Declination: 19½°E

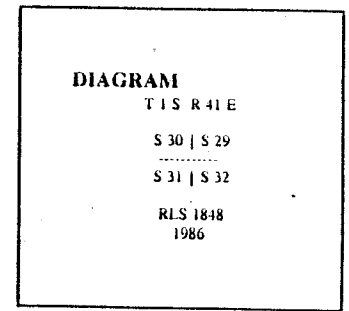
