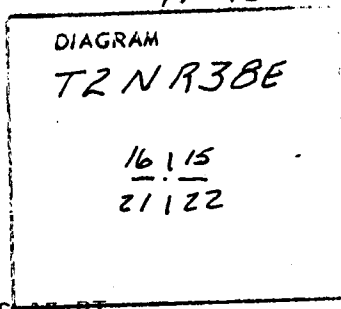


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

N-13

History of original corner establishment:



Corner established by Frank W. Campbell under Contract No. 468 dated April 12, 1883, pages 39 and 40, of the Government Field Notes.

North between Sections 21 and 22, variation 16° East. 80.00 chains set a basalt stone 18" x 10" x 10" 12" in the ground marked three notches on the South and East edges.

- A pine 26" in diam. bears N 70° E 160 lks. marked T 2N R 38E S 15 BT.
- A fir 12" in diam. bears S 88° E 370 lks. marked T 2N R 38E S 22 BT.
- A pine 30" in diam. bears S 31° W 225 lks. marked T 2N R 38E S 21 BT.
- A fir 18" in diam. bears N 41° W 118 lks. marked T 2N R 38 E S 16 BT.

This corner was set September 7, 1883.

No record of subsequent remonumentation found in County Records.

Description of corner evidence found:

I found a rock mound that fits bearings, but no rock was found that fit the original description. (One rock that has approximately 1/3 broken off recently could have fit the original description) but, the distances would not intersect, which is probably due to the BTs over sides of ridge where corner sits to top of ridge.

Found BTs:

- A pine 25.5" in diam. bears N 70° E 105.6', standing dead with visible but not legible scribing.
- A fir 12" in diam. bears S 88° E 178.2', dead broken stump 5' high with faint but visible scribing.
- A pine 23.6" in diam. bears S 31° W 148.5', good BT with scribing visible.
- A fir 18" in diam. bears N 41° W 77.88', dead tree. Wind has blown it down and the tree is rotting on the hillside with a reasonable stump hole.

Original location of this corner

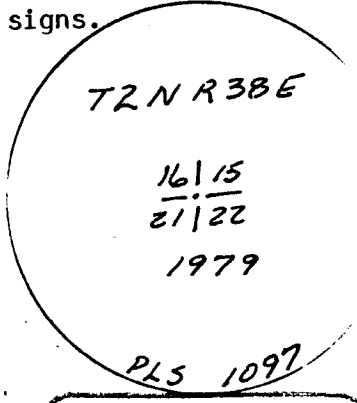
I set a 2½" x 30" iron pipe 1" in the ground and raised a 3' rock mound around the iron pipe with a brass cap marked as shown.

From which I scribed new BTs:

- A pine 10" in diam. bears S 41° E 77.17' scribed T 2N R 38E S 22 BT.
- A pine 16" in diam. bears N 76° E 131.44' scribed T 2N R 38E S 15 BT.
- A fir 12" in diam. bears S 80° W 81.30' scribed T 2N R 38E S 21 BT.
- I also used the pine 23.6" in diam. which bears S 31° W 148.5' which was a good BT and previously scribed N R 38E S 21.

I nailed BT posters and attention signs to BTs.
 I nailed a brass washer marked PLS 1097 to the BT blaze of BTs.
 I set steel posts 15' North and 5' West with attention and boundary signs, and raised rock mounds for each fence post.
 I painted a red band and painted the scribed blazes of BTs red.
 I used a staff compass with 21° declination and a steel chain, measuring all the distances horizontally.
 I painted all visible scribed blazes on the old existing BTs and placed BT and attention signs on them.
 This corner was set September 21, 1979.
