Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the position described above, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe 15" in the ground with an aluminum cap marked as shown. Raised stone mound around cap.

From which I scribed BTs:

A fir 14" in diam. bears S $39^{\circ}39$ ' E 43.0' marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 28 BT. A fir 14" in diam. bears S $31^{\circ}29$ ' W 48.7' marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 29 BT.

I nailed a brass washer marked OPLS 1097 to BT blazes.

I set a steel fence post S 15° E 1.33' with signs 54-4 and 54-9.

I painted a red band around BTs and face of scribe.

I used a steel tape and Wild T-2 and measured a horizontal distance to the center of the BTs.
