Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the position described above, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe 10" in the ground with an aluminum cap marked as shown. Raised stone mound around cap.

From which I scribed BTs:

A pine 30" in diam. bears S $69^{0}05$ ' E 53.8' marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 27 BT. A pine 12" in diam. bears N $28^{0}37$ ' W 56.0' marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 28 BT.

I nailed a brass washer marked OPLS 1097 to BT blazes.

I set a steel fence post South 1.75 feet with signs 54-4 and 54-9.

I painted a red band around BTs and face of scribe.

I used a steel tape and Wild T-2 and measured a horizontal distance to the center of the BTs.
