At the position described above, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe 27" in the ground marked as shown.

From which I scribed BTs:

A fir 17" in diam. bears N $30^{\circ}43$ 'W 13.8' scribed CS 1/16 S 28 BT.\A fir 12" in diam. bears S $75^{\circ}37$ ' W 71.5' scribed CS 1/16 S 28 BT.

I nailed a brass washer marked OPLS 1097 to BT blazes.

I set a steel fence post 5' South with signs 54-2 and 54-4.

I set a fiberglass fence post 5' West with signs 54-2.

I painted a red band around BTs and face of scribe.

I used a steel tape and Wild T-2 and measured a horizontal distance to the center of the BTs.
