Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the position described above, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe 20" in the ground marked as shown. I built a stone mound around the cap.

From which I scribed BTs: .

A fir 21" in diam. bears N $49^{\circ}21$ ' W 92.7' scribed CE 1/16 S 33 BT. A fir 16" in diam. bears S $01^{\circ}28$ ' W 114.9' scribed CE 1/16 S 33 BT.

I nailed a brass washer marked OPLS 1097 to BT blazes.

I set a steel fence post.6' North with signs 54-2 and 54-4.

I set a fiberglass fence post 12" South with sign 54-2.

I painted a red band around BTs and face of scribe.

I used a steel tape and Wild T-2 and measured a horizontal distance to the center of the BTs .
