

At the position described above, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe 24" in the ground marked as shown.

From which I scribed BTs:

A fir 8" in diam. bears N $86^{\circ}18$ ' E 38.3' scribed CS 1/16 S 34 BT. A fir 12" in diam. bears N $47^{\circ}43$ ' W 23.2' scribed CS 1/16 S 34 BT.

I nailed a brass washer marked OPLS 1097 to BT blazes.

I set a steel fence post 5' South with signs 54-2 and 54-4.

I set a fiberglass fence post 5' West with sign 54-2.

I painted a red band around BTs and face of scribe.

I used a steel tape and Wild T-2 and measured a horizontal distance to the center of the BTs.
