



In Survey 032-2019 the position of the monument was found to be set in an erroneous position therefore I reset the monument.

At position determined by survey I reset the 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 29" in the ground, with 2 ½" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which previously established accessories:
