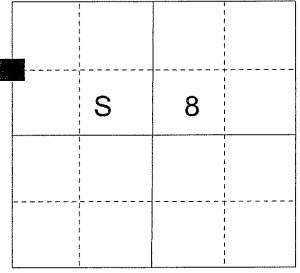

At the position determined by said survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 28" in the ground, from which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

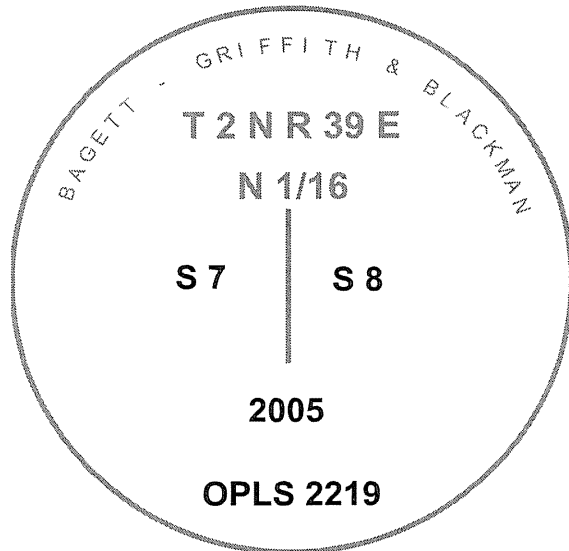
An 8 inch diameter White Fir bears N 56°E, a distance of 26.30 feet, marked N1/16 S8 BT.

A 9 inch diameter Tamarack bears S 39°W, a distance of 20.90 feet, marked N1/16 S7 BT.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on July 6, 2005.

Set steel fence post approximately 1 ft. North of monument.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. The magnetic declination used was 17° East. The distance to the bearing trees is to a 50d spike driven on the right side of the tree at the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 2219 to the BT blaze.
