

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by survey, I set a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum pipe with a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 26" in the ground with a collar of stone 1 foot diameter. From which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

A 6" Western Larch bears North 61° East, a distance of 21.70 feet, marked C 1/4 S9 BT. A 6" Western Larch bears South 66° East, a distance of 28.90 feet, marked C 1/4 S9 BT. A 5" Western Larch bears South 73° West, a distance of 10.45 feet, marked C 1/4 S9 BT. A 5" Western Larch bears North 30° West, a distance of 24.85 feet, marked C 1/4 S9 BT.

I set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot North of the corner monument.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on October 27, 2015.



I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 15° East declination. The distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
