A 6" White Fir bears North 22° East, a distance of 27.35 feet, marked 1/4 S10 BT.

A 9" White Fir bears South 43° East, a distance of 15.30 feet, marked 1/4 S10 BT. A 10" White Fir bears South 33° West, a distance of 29.35 feet, marked 1/4 S9 BT. A 10" White Fir bears North 58° West, a distance of 29.65 feet, marked 1/4 S9 BT.

I set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot North of the corner monument.


