

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by survey, I set a 2 ½" aluminum pipe with a 2 ½" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 28" in the ground. From which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

- A 9" White Fir bears North 72° East, a distance of 14.55 feet, marked C 1/4 S15 BT.
- A 6" White Fir bears South 36° East, a distance of 35.15 feet, marked C 1/4 S15 BT. A 4" Spruce bears South 5° West, a distance of 12.00 feet, marked X BT.
- A 6" White Fir bears West, a distance of 17.00 feet, marked C 1/4 S15 BT.

I set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot North of the corner monument.

Corner falls 16.5 feet Northerly of a fence corner, fences bears South and West.



The distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
