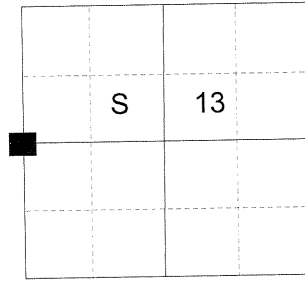

**HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:**

Corner originally established by Rufus S. Moore under GLO contract number 382 dated March 23, 1881. Surveyor General field notes state:

Corner found by Bernard Sutton in 1987. Union County Survey record 041-1996 states:  
No original corner evidence found. Found both references, A stump hole with rotted remains of portion of blaze overgrowth. A stump hole with dead and down pine, open blaze, partially burned, faint scribing "S" with axe marks visible.

At record distance and bearing he set a 5/8"x30" iron rod with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below,  
from which:  
A 9" Ponderosa Pine bears N59°E, 52.9' blazed and scribed 1/4 S13 BT.  
A 12" Ponderosa Pine bears N8°45'W, 15.8' blazed and scribed 1/4 S14 BT.

**DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:**

Found a 5/8" iron pin, 9" above ground, bent South Easterly, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below with a collar of stone 2' diam.

from which:  
A 16" Ponderosa Pine stump bears North 59° East, a dist. of 52.95 ft., with BT tag and healed blaze.  
An approx. 16" stump bears North 44° West, a dist. of 35.65 ft., dead and down lying South Easterly with axe marks and paint.  
A 18" Ponderosa Pine stump bears North 9° West, a dist. of 15.80 ft., with BT tag and healed blaze.

**DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:**

**NEW BEARING OBJECTS:**

A 4" Douglas Fir bears North 44° East, a dist. of 8.60 ft., marked 1/4S13 BT.  
A 3" White Fir bears South 7° East a dist. of 28.00 ft., marked X BT.  
A 5" Douglas Fir bears South 28° West a dist. of 23.50 ft., marked 1/4S14 BT.  
A 5" Ponderosa Pine bears North 47° West a dist. of 13.55 ft., marked 1/4S14 BT.

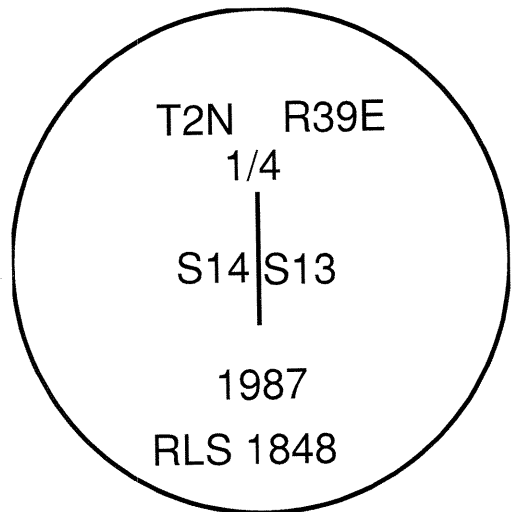

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 13° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
