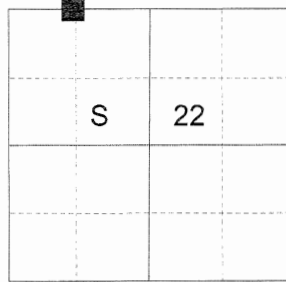

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At point 4 ft. South of a position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 26" in the ground with 2 1/2" Aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

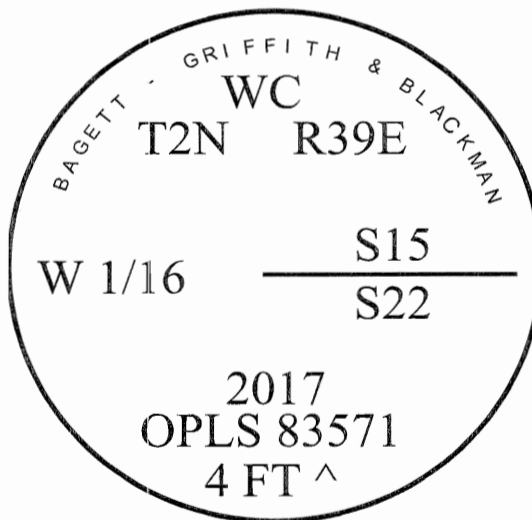
A 8" White Fir bears South 31° East, a distance of 11.40 feet, marked W 1/16 S22 BT.
A 7" White Fir bears North 22° West, a distance of 29.50 feet, marked W 1/16 S15 BT.

Set steel fencepost 1 ft. North of monument

True corner position falls on cut bank of Kingsbury Road.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the bearing trees. Magnetic declination used was 13° East. Bearings are to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the lower blaze of the tree. Distance is to a spike set in the root crown of the side of the tree.
