

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Original corner set by Rufus S. Moore, under GLO contract No. 382, dated March 23, 1881. Surveyor General Record States:

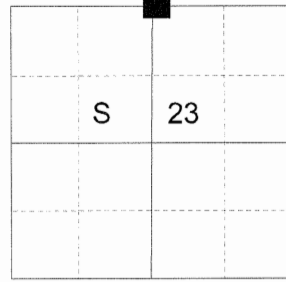
Set post for 1/4 sec. cor.,

from which:

- A Pine, 9 ins. diam. bears N63°W, 16 lks. dist.
- A Pine, 9 ins. diam. bears S13°E, 62 lks. dist.

In 1977 James H. Hambleton as part of Union County survey number 108-77 found the South East bearing tree and set a 5/8" iron pin with plastic cap at record bearing and distance.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found a 5/8" iron pin 4" above ground in 2 ft. collar of stone with broken and crumbling plastic cap marked "LS 645".

from which:

- A 32" Ponderosa Pine bears South 13° East a dist. of 41.15 ft. alive and vigorous with "BT" visible on opened blaze.
- A 12" Douglas Fir bears South 39° East a dist. of 23.70 ft. alive and vigorous with healed blaze and bearing tree tag initialed JHH and dated 11-77.
- A 22" Ponderosa Pine bears North 15° West a dist. of 22.25 ft. alive and vigorous with healed blaze and bearing tree tag initialed JHH and dated 11-77.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At iron pin replaced the crumbling plastic cap with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown from which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

A 7" White Fir bears North 50° East, a distance of 45.95 feet, marked 1/4S14 BT.

Set a steel fence post approx. 1 ft. North.

Kingsbury Rd. runs East/West approx. 100 ft. South.

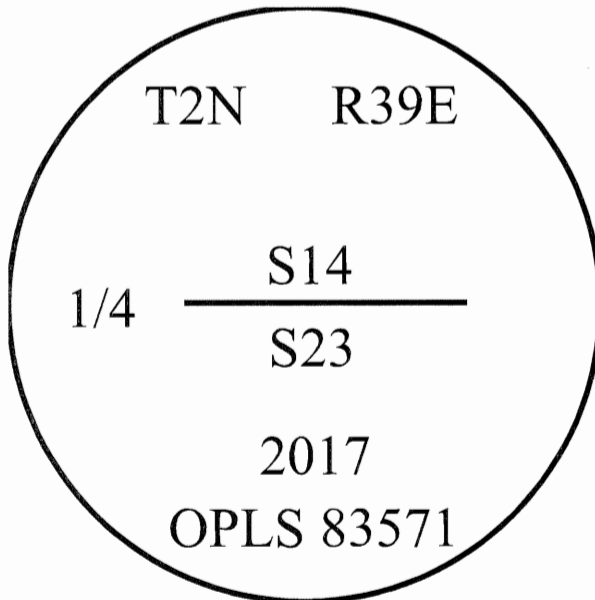

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the bearing trees. Magnetic declination used was 13° East. Bearing is to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the lower blaze of the tree. Distance is to a spike set in the root crown of the side of the tree.
