An 8" Ponderosa Pine bears South 27° East, a distance of 18.10 feet, marked E1/16 S23 BT.
A 9" Ponderosa Pine bears North 53° West, a distance of 49.90 feet, marked E1/16 S14 BT.

Falls in remnants of East and West running barb wire fence.

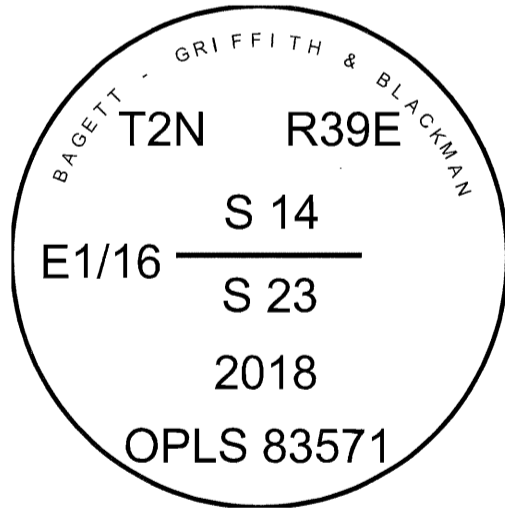

I use a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the bearing trees. Magnetic declination used was 15° East. Distances are to a spike in the root crown of the trees. Bearings are to a brass washer in the lower blaze marked OPLS 83571.
